ODOT Road Work Closes Richmond Road Bridge Just North of White Road

On Tuesday, May 30, the bridge located on Richmond Road just north of White Road was closed to all traffic due to an ODOT construction project. Two-way traffic is expected to be restored by mid-August to beginning of September. The project is expected to be fully complete in the fall. Motorists traveling north on Richmond Road will be to a detour using White Road and Bishop Road. ODOT has posted detour signs in the area, and a new traffic control signal has been added to the intersection of White Road at Bishop Road. Richmond Heights Police and Fire resources have been deployed on both the north side and south side of the bridge closure to respond to calls for service. Thank you to the University Hospitals Richmond Medical Center for providing Richmond Heights safety forces with office space for personnel and a staging area for equipment. Mutual aid agreements are also in place with surrounding police and fire agencies to provide additional assistance to Richmond Heights in the event of an emergency.

Pool Opens Saturday, June 3; Swim Lessons Available

Pool <u>passes</u> are available for purchase at City Hall's Recreation Department. The pool opens Saturday, June 3, and remains open through Sunday, August 13. Weekly <u>swim lessons</u> will be offered through the YMCA at the City's community pool Monday through Thursday each week, from Monday, June 5, through Thursday, August 10. Classes are designed for ages 6 months up to 12 years old. A two-day option costs \$14 weekly, and a four-day option is \$28 per week. Informational Meeting to be Held Tuesday, June 6, to Discuss EPA Construction Project

There will be an informational meeting on Tuesday, June 6, in Richmond Heights City Hall's Council Chambers starting at 6:30 p.m. The purpose of the meeting is to discuss an EPA mandated project that will include construction of an overflow tank at the current Brandywine pump station site between Helmsdale and Balmoral. This tank is to prevent sewage overflows from the pump station. Representatives from the City of Euclid and Richmond Heights as well as Chagrin Valley Engineering and Nerone and Sons Inc. will be on hand to answer questions and give a timeline of construction.
