Next HeartSaver CPR Course is Monday, January 8

A HeartSaver CPR course will be held at the Richmond Heights fire station on Monday, January 8, from 6:30 p.m. to 9:30 p.m. Division of Fire in partnership with UH Richmond Medical Center offers bi-monthly CPR courses to residents of Richmond Heights. The HeartSaver® CPR AED Course is a classroom, video-based, instructor-led course that teaches adult CPR and AED use, as well as how to relieve choking on an adult. This course is for the general public; it is not the Healthcare Provider Course. Participants must be at least 16 years old to attend.
