Highland Road is closed in both directions just west of Georgetown Rd and east of the Metropark Euclid Creek Reservation Drive. Closure is expected until May, 2020 due to bridge replacement. Detour information is posted but prepare for alternate travel routes.

Richmond Road Update

The \$2 million Richmond Road resurfacing project, which is 90% funded by the federal government, was awarded to Burton Scot Contractors. It is currently ahead of schedule with the original completion date being the middle of October.
