Welcome to the City of Richmond Heights Information Line. This recording is updated twice a month, and this is the end of July recording.

The Richmond Heights Kiwanis Club will host its second annual Cruise-In and Sock-Hop on Saturday, July 29, from 4 p.m. to 9 p.m. at Greenwood Farm. Spectator admission is free. Come see cars, trucks and motorcycles on display. DJ Jammin' Joel will provide music, and this year will feature expanded food and drink choices for purchase. Attendees will also be able to participate in a 50/50 raffle. The cost to show a vehicle is \$12. All proceeds benefit the Kiwanis Club Scholarship Fund and service programs that the Club conducts throughout the community.

The second annual National Night Out will take place at City Hall on Tuesday, August 1, from 6 p.m. to 8 p.m. at Richmond Heights City Hall. People of all ages are welcome to sign up in advance for a police-escorted bike ride and decorating contest that will start at 5:30 p.m. at the Richmond Heights Community Park Gazebo. The City will provide youths with bicycle decorations, or feel free to bring your own. The police-escorted ride will take participants through our beautiful Community Park and safely onto the sidewalk on Highland, and then over to the City Hall parking lot, where everyone is encouraged to share in the National Night Out festivities—which span from EMS and police vehicle demonstrations to food, giveaways, games and more. Sign up for the bike ride by stopping by City Hall.

On Wednesday, August 9, the City will host Senior Day at the Park and a Pickleball Tournament from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. at the Richmond Heights Community Park. Seniors are invited to join us for a fun-filled day of games, food, live music by Tom Todd and friendship. Lunch is \$5 and includes a hot dog, snack bag of chips or fruit and a drink. Ice cream, homemade lemonade and kettle corn will be available for an additional, nominal fee. Other attractions at the event include line dancing, yoga, a hula hoop contest, free pool admission for ages 55 and up, storytelling by Judy Bateman, a temporary "tattoo" booth, door prizes and more!
