INTRODUCED BY: Mayor Ursu and Members of Council

*A Resolution Declaring Girl Scout Week, March 11-17, 2012,
in Honor of the 100th Anniversary of the Girl Scouts of the USA*

Whereas Monday, March 12, 2012, marks the 100th Anniversary of the Girl Scouts of the USA, founded by Juliette Gordon Low in 1912 in Savannah, Georgia, with more than 3.4 million current Girl Scout members nationwide celebrating 100 years of this American tradition, with nearly 50 million women who are former Girl Scouts as living proof of the impact of this amazing Movement; and

WHEREAS, throughout its long and distinguished history, Girl Scouting has inspired millions of girls and women with the highest ideals of character, conduct and patriotism; and

WHEREAS, through Girl Scouting girls gain courage, confidence and character that assists in making their communities and the world a better place; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and all of Council desire to publicly acknowledge this milestone of the Girl Scouts of the USA and its active role in increasing girls’ awareness of the opportunities available to them in math, science, health and fitness, technology, and community service that expands their horizons; and

WHEREAS, local Girl Scout Troops 70307 and 70401 also exemplify the outstanding role Girl Scouting plays in our society and those girls and leaders also deserve to be commended; and

WHEREAS, City residents are invited to share in this 100th year celebration by celebrating the commitment Girl Scouting has made to America’s girls and the declaration of the week of March 11-17, 2012 as Girl Scout Week.

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The Mayor and Council of the City of Richmond Heights do highly commend and congratulate the Girl Scouts of the USA on its 100th anniversary, along with Local Troops 70307 and 70401, acknowledge their courage, confidence and character that makes their communities and the world a better place, and declare March 11-17, 2012 as “Girl Scout Week”.
