AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PAY SCHEDULE ORDINANCE (NO. 58-2010) TO ELIMINATE AN AUTHORIZED POSITION IN THE DIVISION OF BUILDING, ZONING AND HOUSING; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, upon the recommendation of the City administration, this Council has determined to eliminate one authorized position in the job classification of Part-time Secretary in the Division of Building, Zoning and Housing due to budgetary constraints and the lack of funds;

NOW, THEREFORE, Be it Ordained by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: Existing Section 8 of Ordinance No. 58-2010, the Pay Schedule Ordinance of the City, is amended only to the extent of eliminating the one authorized position as "Part-Time Secretary" in the Division of Building, Zoning and Housing for the reasons set forth in the preamble of this Ordinance and to hereafter read as follows:

"PHNEx 0 – Part-time Secretary \$8.24 - \$19.82 per hour"

Section 2: The elimination of the authorized position set forth in Section 1 of this Ordinance shall take effect on April 15, 2011, provided the within Ordinance is passed as an emergency measure.

Section 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the general welfare of the City and for the reason that there is a need to eliminate the position which is the subject of this Ordinance at the earliest time possible for budgetary reasons and the lack of funds; wherefore, provided this Ordinance receives the affirmative vote of five members of the Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
