A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE BID OF PLAYWORLD
MIDSTATES FOR LABOR AND MATERIALS FOR A PLAYGROUND
DESIGN, EQUIPMENT, AND INSTALLATION PROJECT AND
AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT THEREFOR.

WHEREAS, bids were received by the City for a playground design, equipment and installation project at the Richmond Heights Elementary School through the Community Development Block Grant Program with such work to be performed in accordance with the specifications prepared therefor and on file with the City; and

WHEREAS, the lowest and best bid received for said professional services was by Playworld Midstates in the amount of \$22,709.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The bid of Playworld Midstates, in the amount of \$22,709.00 for the City's bid specifications for the labor and materials for the project set forth in the preamble to this Resolution under the Community Development Block Grant Program being the lowest and best bid received for such labor and materials be, and the same is hereby, accepted and approved; and the Mayor and Finance Director of the City are authorized to execute and enter into on behalf of the City a proper contract for said labor and materials in accordance with the specifications.

Section 2: The Director of Finance is authorized to appropriate to a proper account a sum sufficient to cover the costs of the contract authorized in Section 1 of this Resolution.

Section 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
