A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE CUYAHOGA COUNTY  
EMERGENCY OPERATIONS PLAN.

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code (“O.R.C.”) Section 5502.271 specifies that each political subdivisions shall establish a program for emergency management if the political subdivision has not entered into a written agreement establishing either a countywide emergency management agency under O.R.C. Section 5502.25 or a regional authority for emergency management under O.R.C. Section 5502.27; and

WHEREAS, the County, by its Resolution No. 090868, as amended, has approved and adopted the Cuyahoga County Emergency Operations Plan (EOP); and

WHEREAS, the County and the Local Community have determined that, in the interest of the public health, safety, and welfare, the CCEOP should be made available to the various political subdivisions within the County and that the effectiveness of the CCEOP will improve with the participation of those subdivisions; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with O.R.C. Sections 307.15 and 5502.29, the Local Community has determined that it wishes to fulfill its obligations under O.R.C. Section 5502.271 by participating in the CCEOP, and the County and the Local Community have determined that each will provide the other reciprocal emergency management aid and assistance; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City Richmond Heights, Ohio, has reviewed the “Cuyahoga County Emergency Operations Plan”.

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The City of Richmond Heights, Ohio, does hereby adopt the Cuyahoga County Emergency Operations Plan.

Section 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
