

RESOLUTION NO.: 66-2011

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING PAYMENT FOR ADDITIONAL WORK BY FOUR WINDS GREEN SOLUTIONS ABOVE AND BEYOND THE CONTRACT FOR LABOR AND MATERIALS FOR REPAIR AND REHABILITATION OF HOMES UNDER THE NEIGHBORHOOD STABLIZATION PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution 50-2010, this Council authorized a contract with Four Winds Green Solutions in the amount of \$159,900.00 for labor and materials for the repair and rehabilitation of homes at 523 Harris Road and 1954 Chelford Road acquired by the City through the federal Neighborhood Stabilization Program; and

WHEREAS, additional work was required to be performed above and beyond the contracted for work in the amount of \$9,117.22 and it is recommended by the City Engineer and the City administration that additional work be performed by Four Winds Green Solutions to the two homes in a total amount of \$5,221.14 as set forth in a memorandum from the City Engineer to the Mayor and Council dated August 22, 2011;

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The Mayor is authorized to enter into an addendum to the contract with Four Winds Green Solutions in the amount of \$14,338.36 for additional work performed and to be performed by said contractor as set forth in the memorandum of the City Engineer to the Mayor and this Council dated August 22, 2011.

Section 2: The Director of Finance is authorized to appropriate to a proper account a sum sufficient to cover the costs of the additional work authorized in Section 1 of this Resolution from Neighborhood Stabilization Program funds.

Section 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4: This Resolution shall be in effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
