A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE BID OF FORTUNA CONSTRUCTION FOR THE CONSTRUCTION AND INSTALLATION OF A SANITARY SEWER AND WATER MAIN IN THE HILLTOP ROAD VICINITY; AND AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT THEREFOR.

WHEREAS, pursuant to legal notice therefor, duly published according to law, sealed bids were received at the Office of the Clerk of Council of the City of Richmond Heights for labor and materials for the construction and installation of a sanitary sewer and water main in the Hilltop Road vicinity in accordance with the specifications prepared by the City Engineer and on file in the Office of the Clerk of Council; and

WHEREAS, pursuant thereto, the lowest and best bid received for said labor and materials for the construction and installation of the subject sanitary sewer and water main is the bid of Fortuna Construction in the total amount of \$145,374.00;

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The bid of Fortuna Construction in the amount of \$145,374.00 for labor and materials for the construction and installation of a sanitary sewer and water main in the Hilltop Road vicinity pursuant to the bid specifications therefor, being the lowest and best bid received for such labor and materials, be, and the same is hereby, accepted and approved; and the Mayor and Director of Finance of the City are authorized to execute and enter into on behalf of the City a proper contract for said labor and materials in accordance with the specifications prepared by the City Engineer.

Section 2: The Director of Finance is authorized to appropriate to a proper account a sum sufficient to cover the costs of the contract authorized in Section 1 of this Resolution from the Neighborhood Stabilization Program funds.

Section 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
