

ORDINANCE NO.: 34 -2010
INTRODUCED BY: Mayor and Council

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE PLAN OF OPERATION
AND GOVERNANCE FOR THE ELECTRICITY
AGGREGATION PROGRAM FOR THE CITY OF RICHMOND
HEIGHTS WITH FIRSTENERGY SOLUTIONS; AND
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Amended Substitute Senate Bill 3 and the vote of the City's electors at the election on November 6, 2001, the City of Richmond Heights determined to provide for its residents an Electric Power Aggregation Plan under which the City would act as the purchasing agent to make available electric power at reduced rates on an opt-out basis; and

WHEREAS, the City has prepared an Electric Power Aggregation Plan of Operation and Governance which is on file with the Clerk of Council and has held two public hearings on the Plan of Operation and Governance on May 11, 2010.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: This Council adopts and approves an Electric Power Aggregation Plan of Operation and Governance known as the "City of Richmond Heights Electric Power Aggregation Plan of Operation and Governance," dated April 13, 2010, a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of Council and which is incorporated herein by reference as if fully rewritten herein.

Section 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

Section 3: This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Richmond Heights and the inhabitants thereof, for the further reason that this Ordinance is required to be immediately effective in order to maximize the potential benefits of the aggregation program for the electricity consumers in the City, and provided it

receives the necessary votes required by the City Charter, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by Council and signature of the Mayor; otherwise to be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
