**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO  
AN AGREEMENT WITH THE INTERNATIONAL ASSOCIATION  
OF FIRE FIGHTERS, LOCAL 2009, AFL-CIO, FOR THE YEARS  
2013 THROUGH 2015; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, the City, by and through its Mayor, Fire Chief and special legal counsel, has negotiated a collective bargaining agreement with representatives of the International Association of Fire Fighters, Local 2009, AFL-CIO, for calendar years 2013 through 2015, and the terms of which have been reviewed by this Council; and

WHEREAS, this Council desires to authorize the Mayor to execute the agreement on behalf of the City;

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The Mayor is authorized and directed to execute an agreement between the City of Richmond Heights and the International Association of Fire Fighters, Local 2009, AFL-CIO, setting forth salary and other terms and conditions of employment with the City, to be effective January 1, 2013, and to remain in effect through December 31, 2015, and to be in the form of the collective bargaining agreement on file with the Clerk of Council and dated August 27, 2013.

Section 2: This Resolution is hereby determined to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Richmond Heights by reason of the need to authorize an agreement for employment conditions for members of the International Association of Fire Fighters, Local 2009, AFL-CIO, as the same affects the day-to-day operations of the City, and particularly its fire safety forces and emergency services, and, therefore, shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
