

RESOLUTION NO. 32 -2014

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A PURCHASE AGREEMENT THROUGH THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES COOPERATIVE PURCHASING PROGRAM FOR A NEW EMERGENCY AMBULANCE VEHICLE FOR THE DIVISION OF FIRE AND TO TRADE IN A USED CITY AMBULANCE.

WHEREAS, Council has authorized cooperative purchasing through the competitive bids obtained by the State of Ohio Department of Administrative Services Cooperative Purchasing Program; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Chief of Fire have advised this Council that the City is in need of a new emergency medical ambulance vehicle, the purchase of which can be made through the State of Ohio's Cooperative Purchasing Program and that the vendor of the new ambulance will accept a trade in of the City's used ambulance, Squad 741 -- a 2001 American Emergency vehicle ambulance (VIN 1FMRU1663YLC36452), and credit the purchase of the new ambulance in the amount of \$16,786.00; and

WHEREAS, Council's Committees have reviewed the need for this proposed purchase and recommend the same and this Council desires to authorize the procurement of this ambulance through the State Cooperative Purchasing Program from Pfund Superior Sales Co., Inc.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The Mayor is authorized to enter into a purchase agreement for one new ambulance, that being a 2015 Ford F-550 Life Line "Custom Superliner" Type 1 ambulance, from Pfund Superior Sales Co., Inc. at a net cost of \$182,491.00, which includes the trade in value of \$12,000.00, under State Schedule Contract Vendor No. 800217, as part of the State of Ohio's Cooperative Purchasing Program.

Section 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in

compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
