A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN
AGREEMENT WITH WEATHERPROOFING TECHNOLOGIES, INC. (WTI)
TO REPAIR FIRE STATION LINTELS.

WHEREAS, the administration has recommended that the City enter into an agreement with Weatherproofing Technologies, Inc. (WTI) to repair the lintels on the south side of the fire station;

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The Mayor is authorized to enter into an agreement with Weatherproofing Technologies, Inc. (WTI) for repair of the lintel on the south side of the fire station in an amount not to exceed Eight Hundred Dollars (\$800.00).

Section 2: The Director of Finance is authorized and directed to appropriate the amount necessary for the agreement authorized in Section 1 of this Resolution from line 233-1300-54700 (Rescue Squad Fund).

Section 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
