

RESOLUTION NO.: 63 -2014

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE APPOINTMENT BY THE MAYOR OF
NINO MONACO AS COMMISSIONER OF BUILDING, ZONING AND HOUSING,
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Article VI, Section 4 (e), of the City of Richmond Heights provides that the Mayor shall appoint the Commissioner of Building, Zoning and Housing with the approval of Council; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor has appointed Nino Monaco as Commission of Building, Zoning and Housing to be effective August 12, 2014.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: This Council hereby approves the action of the Mayor with respect to her appointment of Nino Monaco as Commissioner of Building, Zoning, and Housing, effective August 12, 2014

Section 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3: This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, property, health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary for the Council to provide continuing services in the Division of Building, Zoning and Housing. Therefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of five members of the Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
