

RESOLUTION NO.: 95 -2014

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH GREEN VISION MATERIALS, INC. FOR DISPOSAL OF YARD WASTE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Richmond Heights is in need of a facility at which to dispose of curbside collected yard waste for the period of October 1, 2014 through September 30, 2015; and

WHEREAS, Green Vision Materials, Inc. has facilities at which the City can dispose of yard waste collected by the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The Mayor is authorized to enter into an agreement with Green Vision Materials, Inc. from October 1, 2014 to September 30, 2015, to provide for a facility to dispose of curbside collected yard waste at a cost not to exceed three thousand five hundred dollars (\$3,500.00) to be paid from the general fund.

Section 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3: This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the City of Richmond Heights for the reason that is necessary to immediately provide for the necessary yard waste disposal, and therefore, shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval of the Mayor.
