

RESOLUTION NO.: 96 -2014

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH ROBERT HALF INTERNATIONAL FOR TEMPORARY STAFFING SERVICES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Richmond Heights requires immediate assistance in various City departments which can be provided with temporary staffing until permanent employees are properly hired; and

WHEREAS, Robert Half International and can provide the necessary services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The Mayor is authorized to enter into an agreement with Robert Half International beginning October 8, 2014, to provide the necessary temporary staffing services at a cost not to exceed five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00) to be paid from the general fund.

Section 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3: This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the City of Richmond Heights for the reason that is necessary to immediately provide for the necessary temporary staffing services, and therefore, shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval of the Mayor.
