A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY TO PURCHASE SODIUM CHLORIDE (ROCK SALT) THROUGH THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION'S COOPERATIVE PURCHASING PROGRAM FOR THE 2015-2016 WINTER SEASON.

WHEREAS, Section 5513.01(B) of the Ohio Revised Code and the City's Charter provide the opportunity for the City to participate in contracts of the Ohio Department of Transportation ("ODOT") for the purchase of machinery, material, supplies or other articles, which includes sodium chloride (rock salt); and

WHEREAS, the City's Director of Public Service has recommended participation in the ODOT contract for the winter season of 2015-2016 for the purchase of rock salt for City roadways and sidewalks as a cost savings to the City;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The Mayor is authorized to execute an Agreement for participation in the ODOT cooperative purchasing program Summer (418-16) and/or Winter (018-16) contracts for the purchase of sodium chloride (rock salt) for the City's Department of Public Service for the 2015-2016 winter season, and for the tonnage required, and as determined by the City's Director of Public Service.

Section 2: The Director of Finance is authorized to appropriate to a proper account the amount deemed necessary to cover the minimum cost of the Agreement with ODOT authorized in Section 1 above, and to directly pay vendors, under each such contract of the Ohio Department of Transportation in which the City participates, for items it receives pursuant to the contract.

Section 3: The City of Richmond Heights hereby agrees to be bound by all terms and conditions as the Director of Transportation for ODOT prescribes.

Section 4: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 5: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
