

RESOLUTION NO.: 102 -2016

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE CUYAHOGA COUNTY FISCAL OFFICER TO ADVANCE TAXES AND ASSESSMENTS FROM THE PROCEEDS OF TAX LEVIES PURSUANT TO SECTION 321.34 OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Section 321.34 of the Revised Code of the State of Ohio provides that any money in the County Treasury for credit to the account of the City of Richmond Heights, Ohio, and lawfully applicable to the purpose of the current fiscal year, be drawn upon by request;

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, Ohio, at least five members elected thereto concurring that:

Section 1: The Fiscal Officer of Cuyahoga County, Ohio is requested to draw his warrants and the Treasurer of said County is requested to pay to the City of Richmond Heights, Ohio any money derived from taxes and from assessments in the County Treasury for credit to the account of said City of Richmond Heights, Ohio and lawfully applicable to the purposes of fiscal year 2017.

Section 2: The Clerk of Council is authorized and directed to deliver a certified copy of this Resolution to both the Fiscal Officer and the Treasurer of Cuyahoga County, Ohio.

Section 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4: This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Richmond Heights for the reason that the City treasury must have funds and credit for the City's public purposes and services. Wherefore, this Resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
