**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A PURCHASE AGREEMENT FOR FUEL PUMPS PURSUANT TO THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES' COOPERATIVE PURCHASING PROGRAM.**

WHEREAS, Council has heretofore authorized cooperative purchasing through the competitive bids obtained through the State of Ohio Department of Administrative Services Cooperative Purchase Program; and

WHEREAS, the City has an immediate need to purchase two (2) new fuel pumps, for gasoline and diesel fuel, for its fueling station due to periodic breakdown and spillage of the current pumps which are very old and generally cannot be repaired due to scarcity of replacement parts; and

WHEREAS, two new single product, single hose suction pumps can be purchased through a local Cleveland vendor, Collins Equipment Corp, at or less than the State Contract price under the State's Cooperative Purchasing Program (#RS902813) that will also remove the existing pumps and install the new pumps; and

WHEREAS, an existing agreement with the Richmond Heights Local School District obligates the District to share operational costs with the City based upon usage of fuel.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The Mayor is authorized to enter into an agreement with Collins Equipment Corp for the purchase and installation of two (2) new fuel pumps as set forth in the recitals of this Resolution at a cost not to exceed \$22,000.00 and, pursuant to an existing agreement with the Richmond Heights Local School District, to pursue reimbursement for a portion of this cost from the District.

Section 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
