

RESOLUTION NO.: 37- 2016

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO
A PURCHASE AGREEMENT WITH SPEEDWAY LLC FOR THE
EMERGENCY PURCHASE OF GASOLINE.**

Whereas, the City's two 60+ year-old gasoline pumps are dangerously leaking fuel and cannot be repaired and new pumps are being purchased that will require at least 6 to 8 weeks to order and to install; and

Whereas, the City and the School District will not be able to fuel vehicles at the present pump site and draw fuel from the existing storage tanks during the aforesaid minimum 6 to 8-week period, thereby necessitating the City and School District to fuel vehicles elsewhere and preferably in a location close to the current vehicle storage areas; and

Whereas, this emergency situation has just arisen and the administration has found a gasoline supplier in the City that is located in close proximity and that has a government entity discount program – Speedway LLC.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The Mayor is authorized to enter into a purchase agreement with Speedway LLC to purchase gasoline on a temporary basis and until the City's gasoline pumps are operable; and the purchase shall not exceed \$20,000 without further authorization of this Council. The funds necessary for this purchase have previously been appropriated by this Council through Ordinance No. 12-2016.

Section 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
