

RESOLUTION NO.: 45 -2016

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A PURCHASE AGREEMENT THROUGH THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES' COOPERATIVE PURCHASING PROGRAM FOR ONE VEHICLE FOR USE BY THE DIVISION OF BUILDING, ZONING AND HOUSING.

WHEREAS, this Council has previously authorized cooperative purchasing through the State of Ohio Department of Administrative Services' Cooperative Purchasing Program; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and the Building Commissioner have advised this Council that the City is in need of one (1) Ford Fusion sedan for the Division of Building, Zoning and Housing; and

WHEREAS, Council's Finance Committee has reviewed the need for this proposed purchase and recommends the same to Council; and

WHEREAS, this Council desires to authorize the procurement of one (1) Ford Fusion sedan, the purchase of which can be made through a State-approved vendor, known as Middletown Ford, and for pricing that is at or below the State's Cooperative Purchasing Program price under State Contract No. RS901016, which is in an amount not to exceed \$18,000.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The Mayor is authorized to enter into a purchase agreement with Middletown Ford for the purchase of one (1) Ford Fusion, the description of which is more fully set forth in the preamble of this Resolution for a total cost not to exceed \$18,000.00.

Section 2: The Finance Director is authorized and directed to appropriate to a proper account a sum sufficient to cover the cost of said purchase agreement referred to in Section 1 above.

Section 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
