

RESOLUTION NO.: 61-2016

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A PURCHASE AGREEMENT FOR LED LIGHT FIXTURES AND THE INSTALLATION THEREOF FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SERVICE AND PROPERTIES.

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Service and Properties and this Council's Public Service and Recreation Committee have recommended to the Council as a whole the purchase of LED lighting fixtures for the Department's garage and storage building which will provide much improved and needed lighting for the repair of vehicles and equipment and an overall savings on electricity over several years which will cover the cost of the lighting in just a few years; and

WHEREAS, the Director has obtained quotes for this lighting and its installation and found that Electolite Commercial Lighting Company provided an advantageous quotation to the City for this purchase at \$24,220;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The Mayor is authorized to enter into an agreement with Electolite Commercial Lighting Company for the purchase and installation of 42 LED light fixtures and accessories as proposed to the Director of Public Service and Properties at a cost not to exceed \$24,220.00.

Section 2: To the extent necessary, the Director of Finance is authorized to appropriate to a proper account the amount necessary for the agreement authorized in Section 1 of this Resolution.

Section 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
