**A RESOLUTION HONORARILY NAMING THE CITY COUNCIL  
CHAMBERS "THE MARCIA STARKEY MORGAN COUNCIL CHAMBERS"**

WHEREAS, Marcia Starkey Morgan was the longest-serving elected official in the City's history, the first woman to run for City Council, and a resident of the City of Richmond Heights for over 57 years; and

WHEREAS, Marcia devoted herself to the betterment of the City of Richmond Heights, and represented her constituents with her stellar, tireless and steadfast efforts demonstrating passion, compassion, energy, and professionalism; and

WHEREAS, in recognition of Marcia's long-standing commitment to the City of Richmond Heights, the Mayor and this Council wish to honorarily name the City Council Chambers "The Marcia Starkey Morgan Council Chambers."

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The Mayor and this Council, in appreciation for her service, hereby honorarily name the City Council Chambers "The Marcia Starkey Morgan Council Chambers.

Section 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and signature by the Mayor.
