**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE MUNICIPAL FOREMEN AND LABORERS' UNION LOCAL 1099, FOR THE YEARS 2016 THROUGH 2018; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, the City administration and special labor counsel have negotiated a collective bargaining agreement with representatives of the Municipal Foremen and Laborers' Union, Local 1099; and

WHEREAS, Council desires to authorize the Mayor to execute the agreement on behalf of the City;

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The Mayor is authorized to execute an agreement between the City of Richmond Heights and the Municipal Foremen and Laborers' Union, Local 1099, setting forth salary, hours, terms and conditions of employment with the City to be effective as of January 1, 2016, except as effective dates for various terms of the agreement are set forth therein, and to remain in effect through December 31, 2018, in the form that is on file with the Clerk of Council. The Clerk of Council is authorized, in conjunction with the Law Department, to correct any typographical, ministerial or de minimis items that do not substantially alter the intended results of this ordinance, during the pendency or after the passage of this ordinance.

Section 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3: This Resolution is determined to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Richmond Heights by reason of the need to authorize an agreement for employment conditions for members of the Municipal Foremen and Laborers' Union, Local 1099, as the same affects the day-to-day operation of the City and, therefore, shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
