A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH CARROT-TOP INDUSTRIES, INC. FOR THE PURCHASE OF BANNERS FOR USE BY THE CITY OF RICHMOND HEIGHTS FOR THE CENTENNIAL CELEBRATION.

WHEREAS, Council's Service and Recreation Committee has reviewed the need for this proposed purchase and recommends the same to Council; and

WHEREAS, this Council desires to authorize the purchase of banners from Carrot-Top Industries, Inc. in an amount not to exceed Three Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$3,500.00).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The Mayor is authorized to enter into a contract with Carrot-Top Industries, Inc. for the purchase of banners for use by the City of Richmond Heights for the centennial celebration for a cost not to exceed Three Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$3,500.00).


Section 2: The Finance Director is authorized and directed to appropriate to a proper account a sum sufficient to cover the cost of said purchase referred to in Section 1 above.

Section 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
