A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 55-2017 TO AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH TAHL&S, LLC, DBA HAUETER'S LAWN & SPORT CENTER, FOR THE PURCHASE OF THREE PORTABLE GENERATORS.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 55-2017, Council authorized the Mayor to enter into a contract with Chagrin Pet, Garden & Power Equipment Inc. for the purchase of three portable generators in an amount not to exceed Five Thousand Seven Hundred Dollars (\$5,700.00); and

WHEREAS, the City received quotes from vendors for this equipment purchase and Council's Service and Recreation Committee recommended that the City enter into a contract with Tahl&S, LLC, dba Haueter's Lawn & Sport Center, for the purchase of three portable generators in an amount not to exceed Five Thousand Three Hundred Twenty-Five Dollars (\$5,325.00), however, another vendor was inadvertently included in Resolution No. 55-2017 instead of Tahl&S, LLC, dba Haueter's Lawn & Sport Center; and

WHEREAS, this Council desires to amend Resolution No. 55-2017 to authorize the purchase of three portable generators from Tahl&S, LLC dba Haueter's Lawn & Sport Center in an amount not to exceed Five Thousand Three Hundred Twenty-Five Dollars (\$5,325.00).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:


Section 1: Resolution No. 55-2017 is amended to authorize the Mayor to enter into a contract with Tahl&S, LLC, dba Haueter's Lawn & Sport Center, for the purchase of three (3) portable generators for use by the Service Department in an amount not to exceed Five Thousand Three Hundred Twenty-Five Dollars (\$5,325.00).

Section 2: The Director of Finance is authorized and directed to appropriate to a proper account a sum sufficient to cover the cost of said purchase referred to in Section 1 above.

Section 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


Section 4: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
