

RESOLUTION NO.: 68 -2017

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A PURCHASE AGREEMENT THROUGH THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES' COOPERATIVE PURCHASING PROGRAM FOR EIGHTEEN (18) SETS OF LEVEL IIIA BALLISTIC PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT AND OUTER CARRIERS FOR THE DIVISION OF FIRE.

WHEREAS, Council has authorized cooperative purchasing through the competitive bids obtained by the State of Ohio Department of Administrative Services Cooperative Purchasing Program; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and the Chief of Fire have advised this Council that the City is in need of eighteen (18) sets of level IIIA ballistic personal protective equipment and outer carriers for the Division of Fire; and

WHEREAS, Council's Safety Committee has reviewed the need for this proposed purchase and recommends the same to Council; and

WHEREAS, this Council desires to authorize the purchase of eighteen (18) sets of Summit SMO2 Level IIIA Ballistic Vests and Second Chance V1F Front Opening Outer Carriers, the purchase of which can be made through a State-approved vendor, Atwell's Police and Fire Equipment Company, and for pricing that is at or below the State's Cooperative Purchasing Program price, which is in an amount not to exceed \$12,859.20.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The Mayor is authorized to enter into a purchase agreement with Atwell's Police and Fire Equipment Company for the purchase of eighteen (18) sets of level IIIA ballistic vests and outer carriers at a cost not to exceed \$12,859.20 under State Schedule Contract Vendor No. 800234, as part of the State of Ohio Department of Administrative Services Cooperative Purchasing Program.

Section 2: The Director of Finance is authorized and directed to appropriate to a proper account a sum sufficient to cover the cost of said purchase agreement referred to in Section 1 above.

Section 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
