A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH WOODLAND TREE SERVICE INC. FOR TREE REMOVAL, TREE TRIMMING AND STUMP GRINDING SERVICES AT GREENWOOD FARM.

WHEREAS, the Service Director has obtained a quote from Woodland Tree Service Inc. for tree removal, tree trimming and stump grinding services at Greenwood Farm, specifically to remove five trees, remove dead wood from two trees, and grind four tree stumps as depicted on the work illustration that is part of the quote; and

WHEREAS, Council's Service and Recreation Committee has recommended that Council authorize the Mayor to enter into an agreement with Woodland Tree Service Inc. for tree removal, tree trimming and stump grinding services at Greenwood Farm in an amount not to exceed Three Thousand One Hundred Dollars (\$3,100.00); and

WHEREAS, this Council desires to authorize the Mayor to enter into an agreement with Woodland Tree Service Inc. for tree removal, tree trimming and stump grinding services at Greenwood Farm in an amount not to exceed Three Thousand One Hundred Dollars (\$3,100.00).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:


Section 1: The Mayor is authorized to enter into a contract with Woodland Tree Service Inc. for the removal of five trees, the removal of dead wood from two trees, and the grinding of four tree stumps at Greenwood Farm as depicted on the work illustration that is part of the quote for a cost not to exceed Three Thousand One Hundred Dollars (\$3,100.00).

Section 2: The Director of Finance is authorized and directed to appropriate to a proper account a sum sufficient to cover the cost of the purchase referred to in Section 1 above.

Section 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
