**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH IMPERIAL TREE, INC. FOR THE REMOVAL OF ASH TREES.**

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Service has obtained a quote from Imperial Tree, Inc. for the removal and stump grinding of 32 to 33 ash trees, as determined by said Director, in the tree lawns on Steven Boulevard, Audrey Drive, Albert Court, and Euclid-Chagrin Parkway; and

WHEREAS, Council's Service and Recreation Committee has recommended that Council authorize the Mayor to enter into an agreement with Imperial Tree, Inc. for the removal and stump grinding of 32 to 33 ash trees, as determined by the Director, in an amount not to exceed Eight Thousand Two Hundred Dollars (\$8,200.00); and

WHEREAS, this Council desires to authorize the Mayor to enter into an agreement with Imperial Tree, Inc. for the removal and stump grinding of the ash trees in an amount not to exceed Eight Thousand Two Hundred Dollars (\$8,200.00).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The Mayor is authorized to enter into a contract with Imperial Tree, Inc. for the removal and stump grinding of 32 to 33 ash trees, as determined by the Director of Public Service, in the tree lawns on Steven Boulevard, Audrey Drive, Albert Court, and Euclid-Chagrin Parkway for a cost not to exceed Eight Thousand Two Hundred Dollars (\$8,200.00).

Section 2: The Director of Finance is authorized and directed to appropriate to a proper account a sum sufficient to cover the cost of the purchase referred to in Section 1 above.

Section 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
