

RESOLUTION NO.: 96-2017

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A RENEWAL CONTRACT WITH TYCO SIMPLEX/GRINNELL FOR INSPECTION, MAINTENANCE AND REPAIR SERVICES FOR THE POLICE STATION AND JAIL SYSTEMS.

WHEREAS, the City is in need of ongoing inspection, maintenance, and repair services for fire alarm, access control, closed circuit TV, sound and communications systems within the Police Station and jail; and

WHEREAS, Tyco Simplex/Grinnell has successfully and reliably performed those services for the City by contract over the past several years and is a sole source for these services due to its equipment having been installed in the City's Police Station and jail for these systems and the critical safety and emergency needs of these systems; and

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police has received a contract renewal from Tyco Simplex/Grinnell for the foregoing services at an annual cost not to exceed \$7,657.25; and

WHEREAS, the Safety Committee and the Finance Committee recommended that Council authorize the Mayor to enter into a renewal contract with Tyco Simplex/Grinnell for inspection, maintenance and repair services for the City's police station and jail systems at an annual cost not to exceed \$7,657.25; and

WHEREAS, Council determines it to be in the best interest of the City to authorize the Mayor to enter into a renewal contract with Tyco Simplex/Grinnell for inspection, maintenance and repair services for the police station and jail at an annual cost not to exceed \$7,657.25.

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The Mayor is authorized to enter into a contract with Tyco Simplex/Grinnell for the comprehensive services set forth in the preamble to this Resolution at an annual cost not to exceed \$7,657.25.

Section 2: The funds necessary for the contract authorized in Section 1 of this Resolution have been appropriated by this Council.

Section 3: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
