A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH WEATHERPROOFING TECHNOLOGIES, INC. FOR PATCH WORK ON PORTIONS OF THE SERVICE DEPARTMENT GARAGE ROOF.

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Service and Properties has obtained a quote from Weatherproofing Technologies, Inc. (hereinafter "WTI") for patch work to designated areas of the Service Department garage roof,; and

WHEREAS, Council's Service and Recreation Committee has recommended that Council authorize the Mayor to enter into an agreement with WTI for the roof patch work in an amount not to exceed Twenty-Four Thousand Five Hundred Fifty-One Dollars and Fifty-One Cents (\$24,551.51); and

WHEREAS, this Council desires to authorize the Mayor to enter into such an agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:


Section 1: The Mayor is authorized to enter into a contract with WTI for the roof patch work for a cost not to exceed Twenty-Four Thousand Five Hundred Fifty-One Dollars and Fifty-One Cents (\$24,551.51).

Section 2: If necessary, the Director of Finance is authorized and directed to appropriate to a proper account the amount authorized in Section 1 of this Resolution.

Section 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time provided by law.
