

RESOLUTION NO.: 118 - 2017

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A PURCHASE AGREEMENT FOR TWO (2) VEHICLES FOR USE BY THE DIVISION OF POLICE.

WHEREAS, Council has heretofore authorized cooperative purchasing through the State of Ohio Department of Administrative Services' Cooperative Purchase Program and the Charter of the City authorizes such purchases; and

WHEREAS, the Police Chief has advised this Council that the Division of Police is in need of two (2) new police vehicles, the purchase of which can be made from a vendor through the State of Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Program at \$52,064.00; and

WHEREAS, Council's Safety and Finance Committees have reviewed the need for the vehicles, and this Council desires to authorize the procurement of the vehicles from Lebanon Ford Inc., Lebanon, Ohio.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The Mayor is authorized to enter into a purchase agreement with Lebanon Ford Inc., 770 Columbus Ave., Lebanon, Ohio 45036, for the purchase of one (1) model year 2018 Ford Utility Police Interceptor vehicle and one (1) 2018 Ford Sedan Police Interceptor vehicle for a total cost not to exceed \$52,064.00 through State Contract No. GDC050, RS900718-2, as part of the State of Ohio's Cooperative Purchasing Program.


Section 2: The Director of Finance is authorized and directed to appropriate to a proper account a sum sufficient to cover the cost of the purchase agreement in Section 1 above.

Section 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
