

RESOLUTION NO.: 35 -2018

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH SOLAR WINDOWS FOR THE PURCHASE AND INSTALLATION OF GUTTERS AND RELATED WORK AT THE CITY'S KIWANIS LODGE.

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Service and Properties has obtained a quote from "Solar Windows and More" of Strongsville, Ohio ("Solar Windows") to install six (6)-inch gutters and 3x4-inch downspouts with the "Leaf Relief System", including the replacement of wood where needed and a 10-year warranty, at the Kiwanis Lodge in an amount not to exceed Four Thousand Eight Hundred Dollars (\$4,800.00); and

WHEREAS, Council's Service and Recreation Committee has recommended that Council authorize the Mayor to enter into an agreement with Solar Windows for the above-described improvements at the Kiwanis Lodge in an amount not to exceed Four Thousand Eight Hundred Dollars (\$4,800.00).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:


Section 1: The Mayor is authorized to enter into an agreement with Solar Windows for the purchase and installation of six (6)-inch gutters and 3x4-inch downspouts with the Leaf Relief System, including the replacement of wood where needed and a 10-year warranty, at the City's Kiwanis Lodge in an amount not to exceed Four Thousand Eight Hundred Dollars (\$4,800.00).

Section 2: The Director of Finance is authorized and directed to appropriate to a sum sufficient to cover the cost of the agreement referred to in Section 1 above from the City's Fund No. 401.

Section 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
