A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER AN AGREEMENT WITH TYCO SIMPLEX/GRINNELL FOR VIDEO SURVEILLANCE UPGRADES FOR THE POLICE STATION.

WHEREAS, the City is in need of an updated IP server to support its video surveillance systems within the Police Station; and

WHEREAS, Tyco Simplex/Grinnell has successfully and reliably provided and serviced equipment for the City by contract over the past several years; and

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police has received a quote from Tyco Simplex/Grinnell for a Panasonic IP Server, which will be furnished, installed, programmed, and tested by Tyco Simplex/Grinnell for a cost not to exceed Four Thousand Dollars (\$4,000.00); and

WHEREAS, Council's Service and Recreation Committee has recommended that Council authorize the Mayor to enter into an agreement with Tyco Simplex/Grinnell for the aforesaid updated server.

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:


Section 1: The Mayor is authorized to enter into a contract with Tyco Simplex/Grinnell for Tyco Simplex/Grinnell to furnish, install, program, and test one (1) Panasonic IP Server, set forth in the preamble to this Resolution, at a cost not to exceed Four Thousand Dollars (\$4,000.00).

Section 2: To the extent necessary, the Director of Finance is authorized and directed to appropriate to a proper account a sum sufficient to cover the cost referred to in Section 1 above.

Section 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
