

RESOLUTION NO. 91-2018

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING PAYMENT TO COLLINS EQUIPMENT CORP. FOR THE EMERGENCY INSPECTION AND REPAIR OF A GASOLINE PUMP AT THE SERVICE DEPARTMENT FACILITY.

WHEREAS, last month, an emergency repair was required at the Service Department facility located at 26260 Chardonview Road which included both the inspect and repair the suction line for the unleaded gasoline suction pump;

WHEREAS, Collins Equipment Corp. inspected the line and pump and performed required repairs, including cleaning the barrel check valve; installing a union check valve in the suction line; removing and replacing the steel suction line installed in the piping sump from the tank to the fiberglass suction line; and installing a 1-1/2" suction stub inside the old 2" suction stub; and

WHEREAS, this Council desires to authorize the payment of \$5,259.00 to Collins Equipment Corp. for the emergency services described above.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: Authority is granted to the Mayor for payment to Collins Equipment Corp. for the inspection and repair services described in the recitals of this Resolution, in the amount of \$5,259.00.

Section 2: If necessary, the Director of Finance is authorized to appropriate to a proper account the amount necessary to cover the agreement that is the subject of Section 1 of this Resolution.

Section 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
