A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DISCARDING OF ABANDONED PROPERTY THAT IS UNNEEDED, OBSOLETE, AND UNFIT FOR CITY PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Greenwood Farm Board has recommended the discarding of personal property which has been abandoned and/or donated to the City and which is of no value and is unneeded, obsolete and unfit for municipal purposes; and

WHEREAS, Section 721.15 of the Ohio Revised Code provides for the discarding of such property by authorization of this City Council.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The Director of Public Service and Properties is authorized to discard of the personal property which has been abandoned and/or donated to the City and which of no value and is unneeded, obsolete, and unfit for municipal purposes.

Section 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.


