A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A CHANGE ORDER TO THE CONTRACT
WITH VECTOR CONSTRUCTION, INC. FOR THE KIWANIS LODGE
COMMUNITY CENTER ACCESSIBILITY PROJECT

WHEREAS, it is the consensus of the Mayor and Council that extra work is needed to be performed while Vector Construction, Inc. is performing work to make the City's Kiwanis Lodge Community Center compliant with the Americans with Disabilities Act ("ADA"), which work includes, among other improvements, making the restrooms and kitchenette ADA compliant (the "Project");

WHEREAS, the original contract price of \$182,700.00 was authorized by Resolution No. 121-2018 of this Council;

WHEREAS, the additional work described in the Change Orders attached hereto as Exhibit A will result in the Project exceeding the original contract price of \$182,700.00 by \$181.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:


Section 1: The Mayor is hereby authorized to execute a change order to the contract with Vector Construction, Inc. to increase the total authorized amount of the contract with said company by an additional \$181.00 to a total amount of \$182,881.00 for the extra work described in Exhibit A to this Resolution.

Section 2: To the extent necessary, the Finance Director of Finance is authorized to appropriate to a proper account a sum sufficient to cover the cost of the aforesaid change order approved in Section 1 of this Resolution.

Section 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


Section 4: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
