A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN EXTENSION OF A CONSULTING AGREEMENT WITH PAS INSPECTION CO., LLC FOR OHIO CERTIFIED BUILDING INSPECTION AND BUILDING CODE ADMINISTRATIVE CONSULTING SERVICES.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 40-2018 of this Council, the Mayor was authorized to enter into a consulting agreement with PAS Inspection Co., Inc. for Ohio certified building inspection services and Building Code administrative consulting services for calendar year 2018 and the Mayor and the Commissioner of the Division of Building, Zoning and Housing wish to extend that agreement for calendar year 2019 with an authorization of \$10,000 for the services in 2019;

WHEREAS, PAS Inspection Co., LLC has proven over the past year to have the experience to provide consulting and support services in this regard;

WHEREAS, this Council desires to authorize the Mayor to extend the aforesaid consulting agreement on an "as needed" basis to be determined by the Mayor with the cost thereof not exceeding Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00) in calendar year 2019.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The Mayor is authorized to extend the consulting agreement with PAS Inspection Co., LLC for Ohio certified building inspection and building code administrative consulting services on an as-needed basis for a term from January 1, 2019 through December 31, 2019 with the cost thereof not to exceed Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000) in 2019.

Section 2: If necessary, the Director of Finance is authorized to appropriate to a proper account a sum sufficient to cover the cost of the agreement set forth in Section 1 above.

Section 3: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.


