

RESOLUTION NO.: 69 -2019

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH GEAUGA ALARMS, INC. FOR THE PURCHASE AND INSTALLATION OF A FIRE ALARM SYSTEM AT THE CITY'S KIWANIS LODGE.

WHEREAS, the Chief of Fire obtained price quotations from three vendors of fire alarm systems for the City's Kiwanis Lodge and Geauga Alarms, Inc. was the lowest quotation to sell and install a Code-compliant fire alarm system at the Lodge in an amount not to exceed Six Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$6,500.00);

WHEREAS, Council's Safety and Finance Committees have recommended that Council authorize the Mayor to enter into an agreement with Geauga Alarms, Inc. for the purchase and installation of a fire alarm system at the Kiwanis Lodge in an amount not to exceed Six Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$6,500.00).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:


Section 1: The Mayor is authorized to enter into an agreement with Geauga Alarms, Inc. for the purchase and installation of a Code-compliant fire alarm system at the City's Kiwanis Lodge in an amount not to exceed Six Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$6,500.00).

Section 2: If necessary, the Director of Finance is authorized and directed to appropriate to a sum sufficient to cover the cost of the agreement referred to in Section 1 above.

Section 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.


