

RESOLUTION NO.: 100-2019

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH VECTOR CONSTRUCTION, INC. FOR THE ALL-WEATHER ENCLOSURE AT THE CITY'S KIWANIS LODGE COMMUNITY CENTER.

WHEREAS, the Directors of Economic Development and Public Service and Properties have obtained competitive bids for construction of an all-weather enclosure over the handicapped accessible entrance to the City's Kiwanis Lodge Community Center, as further detailed in the bid proposal submitted by Vector Construction, Inc. ("Vector"), one of two bidders on the Project;

WHEREAS, Vector's bid for the Project with deductions is Seventy-Four Thousand Two Hundred Dollars (\$74,200.00);

WHEREAS, the City administration and the Council Finance Committee is recommending acceptance of the bid of Vector as the lowest and best bid for the Project;

WHEREAS, the City has received a \$50,000 grant from Cuyahoga County as a reimbursement for the partial cost of this Project;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The Mayor is authorized to enter into a contract with Vector Construction, Inc. for the Project as described in the preamble to this Resolution based on the bid proposal submitted by Vector at a cost not to exceed Seventy-Four Thousand Two Hundred Dollars (\$74,200.00).

Section 2: The Director of Finance is authorized and directed to appropriate to a proper account a sum sufficient to cover the cost of the contract referred to in Section 1 above.

Section 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


Section 4: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
