**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO
AN AGREEMENT FOR OUTFITTING A NEW POLICE VEHICLE
WITH NECESSARY ACCESSORY EQUIPMENT.**

Whereas, the Police Chief has advised this Council that the Division of Police is in need of outfitting a newly-purchased police vehicle (Chevrolet Tahoe) with special police equipment, the purchase and installation of which can be made through Hall Public Safety Co. after obtaining quotations from other vendors;

Whereas, Council's Public Safety and Finance Committees have reviewed the need to outfit the new police vehicle with necessary accessory equipment and recommended the purchase and installation thereof from Hall Public Safety Co. in an amount not to exceed \$13,500.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:


Section 1: The Mayor is authorized to enter into an agreement with Hall Public Safety Co. for the purchase and installation of accessory equipment to outfit a newly-purchase Chevrolet Tahoe police vehicle for a total cost not to exceed \$13,500.

Section 2: If necessary, the Director of Finance is authorized and directed to appropriate to a proper account a sum sufficient to cover the cost of the agreement referred to in Section 1 above.

Section 4: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 5: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
