

ORDINANCE NO.: 136-2021

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CITY'S PAY ORDINANCE NO. 82-2021 TO PROVIDE COMPENSATION FOR CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION MEMBERS OF THE CITY; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Mayor has recommended and the current Civil Service Commission members have agreed that Civil Service Commission members should be compensated for their duties, and it is necessary to amend Ordinance No. 82-2021, adopted by this Council on August 24, 2021, to do so;

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Ordained by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: Section 6 of Ordinance No. 82-2021, the Pay Ordinance of the City, is amended to provide compensation for all Civil Service Commission members, as follows, and the remainder of Section 6 shall remain unchanged:

Section 6. BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS.

Civil Service Commission


Each board and commission member, including the Chair, must sign a certification form provided by the Director of Finance that he/she was present at a meeting of the board or commission of which he/she is a member/Chair as authorization to be paid for that meeting. A quorum must be present at the meeting for those members/Chair in attendance to receive compensation for that meeting. Compensation for attendance at a meeting that is not a regular meeting of the board or commission shall only be paid if authorized in writing by the Mayor in advance of the meeting and the certification form is counter-signed by the Mayor. All compensation will be paid monthly.

Section 2. The compensation provided for in the amendment in Section 1 of this Ordinance shall be effective retroactive to December 1, 2021.

Section 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of the Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.


Section 4. This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the City in that it is required to provide compensation for all Civil Service Commission members at the earliest possible date and further for the purpose of continued efficient and effective operation of the municipal government and the continuation of necessary City services. Wherefore, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage by Council and signature of the Mayor.
