A Resolution of Recognition and Commendation for the 60th Anniversary of the Richmond Heights Volunteer Auxiliary Police Unit

WHEREAS, the City of Richmond Heights instituted a Volunteer Auxiliary Police Unit in 1961, as reported upon the cover page of the November, 1961 edition of *The Richmond Heights Reporter*, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit A, which Unit has been in continuous existence and operation ever since;

WHEREAS, the Volunteer Auxiliary Police Unit has provided valuable assistance and support to the City's Division of Police and the community in a variety of functions, including such services as road patrol, assistance at emergencies, crime prevention, and community policing;

WHEREAS, the Auxiliary Unit's Officers have collectively provided over 88,000 estimated hours of volunteer service time to the community since the inception of the Unit;

WHEREAS, the Mayor and all of Council desire to publicly acknowledge this 60-year milestone of the Richmond Heights Voluntary Auxiliary Police Unit, its record of exemplary continuous service to the community of Richmond Heights, and its active and effective role in supporting the Division of Police and making the community a safer and better place to live.


NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:
