A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING PAYMENT OF ADDITIONAL PROJECT COSTS TO THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR THE RICHMOND ROAD RESURFACING PROJECT FOR NECESSARY ADDITIONAL CONCRETE REPAIRS AND TOPSOIL QUANTITIES AS REQUESTED BY THE CITY.

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 134-2018, passed by this Council on August 14, 2018, the City agreed to cooperate with the Ohio Department of Transportation ("ODOT") for the construction of the Richmond Road Resurfacing Project (the "Project") to be constructed by ODOT with the payment of the City's local share of the Project in the estimated amount of Two Hundred Thirty- Four Thousand Five Hundred Thirty-Eight Dollars (\$234,538.00);

WHEREAS, construction of the Project has been completed, and unforeseen extra work was needed to be performed relating to base concrete repairs and additional topsoil quantities, as requested by the City, which was deemed to be necessary and has been approved by the City Engineer, the cost of which will exceed the originally authorized local share of \$234,538 by the amount of \$20,420.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The payment of \$20,420 to ODOT for extra work for additional concrete repairs and topsoil quantities necessary for the completion of the Project for items requested by the City is hereby authorized and the Director of Finance is authorized to remit payment to ODOT in that amount.

Section 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
