

RESOLUTION NO.: 25-2021

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH FLOCK SAFETY FOR THE PROVISION OF LICENSE PLATE READING CAMERAS AND ANNUAL SUBSCRIPTION SERVICES FOR A PERIOD OF ONE (1) YEAR FOR THE DIVISION OF POLICE.

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police has advised this Council that the Division of Police is in need of two (2) license plate reading cameras and annual subscription services for a period of one (1) year;

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police has obtained a proposal dated March 17, 2021 from Flock Safety for the provision of such cameras and annual subscription services for a total cost of \$5,500.00;

WHEREAS, Council's Safety Committee and Finance Committee have reviewed the need for this proposed purchase and recommend the same to Council and Council desires to authorize the purchase of two (2) license plate reading cameras and annual subscription services for a period of one (1) year from Flock Safety for an amount not to exceed \$5,500.00;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The Mayor is authorized to enter into a purchase agreement with Flock Safety for the purchase of two (2) license plate reading cameras and annual subscription services for a period of one (1) year for an amount not to exceed \$5,500.00;

Section 2: If necessary, the Director of Finance is authorized and directed to appropriate to a proper account a sum sufficient to cover the cost of the purchase agreement in Section 1 above.

Section 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


Section 4: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
