A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A PURCHASE AGREEMENT WITH TIM LALLY CHEVROLET FOR A PICKUP TRUCK AT A COST AT OR BELOW THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES COOPERATIVE PURCHASING PROGRAM BID PRICING FOR AN EQUIVALENT PICKUP TRUCK FOR USE BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SERVICE.

WHEREAS, Council has heretofore authorized cooperative purchasing through the State of Ohio Department of Administrative Services' Cooperative Purchase Program and purchases from vendors offering pricing at or below State Purchasing Program bid pricing;

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Service has advised this Council that the Public Service Department is in need of a new 4x4 pickup truck;

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Service has received a proposal from Tim Lally Chevrolet, Inc., 24999 Miles Road, Warrensville Heights, Ohio 44128 for one (1) 2022 Chevrolet Silverado HD 2500 4x4 Regular Cab Pickup Truck for the amount of \$30,919.00, which is at or below the State Cooperative Purchasing Program price for the equivalent Ford F250 4x4 Pickup Truck bid price;

WHEREAS, Council's Service and Recreation Committee has reviewed the need for this proposed purchase and recommends the same to Council;

WHEREAS, this Council desires to authorize the procurement from Tim Lally Chevrolet, Inc., of one (1) 2022 Chevrolet Silverado HD 2500 4x4 Regular Cab Pickup Truck for the amount of \$30,919.00, which is priced at or below the State Cooperative Purchasing Program bid price for the equivalent Ford F250 4x4 Pickup Truck, for an amount not to exceed \$30,919.00.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The Mayor is authorized to enter into a purchase agreement for the purchase of one (1) 2022 Chevrolet Silverado HD 2500 4x4 Regular Cab Pickup Truck from Tim Lally Chevrolet, Inc. in Warrensville Heights, Ohio at a cost not to exceed \$30,919.00, as set forth in the recitals to this Resolution.

Section 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


Section 4: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
