A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT THROUGH THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION'S COOPERATIVE PURCHASING PROGRAM FOR THE PURCHASE OF ONE FREIGHTLINER TRUCK CAB AND CHASSIS FOR USE BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SERVICE.

WHEREAS, this Council has previously authorized cooperative purchasing through the Ohio Department of Transportation Cooperative Purchasing Program;

WHEREAS, the Service Director received a proposal dated April 8, 2021, from Valley Freightliner & Western Star, an approved vendor for the Ohio Department of Transportation Cooperative Purchasing Program, for one (1) M2 106 Freightliner truck cab and chassis for the amount of \$68,556.00;

WHEREAS, based upon the recommendation of the Service Director to purchase the Freightliner from this vendor, this Council desires to authorize the procurement of one (1) M2 106 Freightliner truck cab and chassis through a State-approved vendor, Valley Freightliner & Western Star, through the Ohio Department of Transportation's Cooperative Purchasing Program under ODOT Contract No. 023-21 in an amount not to exceed \$68,556.00;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The Mayor is authorized to enter into a purchase agreement with Valley Freightliner & Western Star for the purchase of one (1) M2 106 Freightliner truck cab and chassis for a total cost not to exceed \$68,556.00.


Section 2: The Finance Director is authorized and directed to appropriate to a proper account a sum sufficient to cover the cost of said purchase agreement referred to in Section 1 above.

Section 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time permitted by law.


