A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH CHARDON WELDING, INC. FOR THE PURCHASE OF A SALT SPREADER FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SERVICE.

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Service has recommended that the City purchase a salt spreader for the City's 1-ton truck to provide for necessary street salting until the City takes delivery of new trucks in 2022;

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Service has received a quote from Chardon Welding, Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$7,200.00 for a 9-foot 4.5 cubic yard Western Stainless Steel Striker Hopper Spreader for the Department of Public Service and recommends to this Council to enter into an agreement with Chardon Welding, Inc. for purchase of the same;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The Mayor is authorized to enter into an agreement with Chardon Welding, Inc. for the purchase of a 9-foot 4.5 cubic yard Western Stainless Steel Striker Hopper Spreader for the Department of Public Service in an amount not to exceed \$7,200.00.

Section 2: If necessary, the Director of Finance is authorized and directed to appropriate to a proper account a sum sufficient to cover the cost of the purchases referred to in Section 1 above.

Section 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4: This Resolution shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.
