**A RESOLUTION RATIFYING AND AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT  
WITH TRUCK SERVICE, INC. TO PERFORM NECESSARY REPAIRS  
TO A CITY TRUCK.**

WHEREAS, pursuant to §131.04 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Richmond Heights, the Mayor is authorized to enter into and to execute on behalf of the City all contracts for services, goods, materials and supplies in an amount not to exceed five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00) for each contract, provided that the necessary appropriation therefor has been made by the Council and the Director of Finance attaches to each contract a fiscal offer's certificate as required by the Charter and state law;

WHEREAS, one of the Service Department salt trucks (#R20) required front springs and king pin repairs, which were performed at Truck Service, Inc., aka Cleveland Spring, which came to \$7,652.14, an amount in excess of the Mayor's authority to contract;

WHEREAS, this Council desires to ratify and authorize the contract with Truck Service, Inc. for the aforesaid necessary repairs to the City's salt truck in the amount of \$7,652.14;


NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Council of the City of Richmond Heights, State of Ohio, that:

**SECTION 1:** This Council hereby ratifies and authorizes the contract with Truck Service, Inc. in the amount of \$7,652.14 for necessary repairs to the City's salt truck #R20.

**SECTION 2:** It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


**SECTION 3:** This Resolution shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time permitted by law.
